



## WOODED GLEN HOA TRASH AND RECYCLING

### *Service Information*

- **Trash:** Monday and Thursday. Collection hours are 6 AM to 6 PM. Please have ALL trash bagged and curbside by 5:45 AM.
- **Bulk Items:** Thursday for items weighing 50lbs or less and 4ft. square or less. To schedule larger items, call 703-818-8222.
- **Recycling:** Thursday. Collection hours are 6 AM to 6 PM.
- **Yard Waste:** Wednesday from March 1<sup>st</sup> through Dec. 24<sup>th</sup>. During January and February, you may place yard debris out with your household trash.
- **Holidays:** There will be no collection on the following holidays, and collection will resume on your next regularly scheduled pick up day: New Year's Day, Independence Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas or other days that the local transfer stations/landfills are closed.

### *Household Trash & Recycling Service Details*

- Republic Services provides one 96 - gallon Trash Container. If you need a new cart or a replacement or repair, please contact our office at 703-818-8222.
- Republic Services provides one 35- gallon Recycling Cart. If you need a new cart, or a replacement or repair, please contact our office at 703-818-8222.
- All equipment provided by Republic Services will remain the property of Republic Services.
- Republic Services will collect mixed paper, cardboard and paperboard boxes (to include pizza boxes), newspaper, magazines, and books (hardcover and paperback), food/beverage glass and plastic bottles, plastics labeled 1 thru 7, food/beverage aluminum & tin, corrugated cardboard & fiber-board; **all recyclables can be placed together.**
- **Christmas trees** will be collected the first two Wednesday's of January. Trees must be placed at the curb prior to 6 a.m. All tinsel and ornaments must be removed from the tree. Please do not place in bags.

### *Yard Waste Collection*

- Yard Waste is considered a by-product of regular yard maintenance and not the debris as a result of landscaping renovation.
- Recycling of yard debris is mandatory from March 1 through December 31. January and February, please place yard debris out with your household trash.
- All yard debris to be collected must be prepared accordingly and placed at the curb for collection:
  - Brush and limbs must be cut into 4-foot lengths and bundled (arm-full size) with rope or twine and should not exceed 50 pounds.
  - Grass clippings, leaves, and twig can be placed in a container you provide, paper bags, or clear plastic bags. Yard waste placed in dark bags will not be collected unless marked with an X.
  - Tree stumps and tree limbs that are larger the 6 inches in diameter and 4 feet in length will not be collected.
  - All unbundled brush will be considered a special pick up.

### *Special Items*

- Residents are limited to bulk items equivalent to 2 cubic yards and/or 50 lbs. or less. Larger items require a special pick-up billed to the homeowner. Ferrous metal/white good items, such as appliances, will be picked up with additional billing to the individual homeowner.
- Prior notice is requested when any large items are to be disposed, please call Republic Services Customer Service Center at 703-818-8222.
- All appliances (white goods) must be scheduled by the individual resident prior to removal.
- All appliances containing Freon (CFC's) must be tagged with certification that it is FREON-FREE prior to removal.
- Contact your Heating and Air Conditioning dealer for CFC removal or Republic Services can provide this service for an additional fee to you.
- All lawn mowers must be free of oil and gasoline prior to collection.

### *We will NOT Pickup*

- Rocks, concrete, dirt, tires, soil, sod, tree stumps, paint, motor oil, construction trash/renovation debris, combustibles, toxic or hazardous wastes, or any other material excluded from the disposal site, or any applicable state or federal law, as being hazardous or toxic.
- As well as flammable products, dead animals, fecal matter, manure, brick, landscaping timbers, friable asbestos, lead acid/wet cell batteries, bio-hazardous material, needles, and other medical waste.
- Containers or bundles weighing more than 50 pounds or exceed 4 feet in length will not be collect as household trash. Please call the Customer Service Center to put in a request to have a Residential Supervisor survey the material for a quote. This survey and removal of the debris will be billed to the homwowner.
- Any items that cannot be safely loaded by our crews for removal or any items that may damage the hauling equipment will not be collected. Republic Services' crews cannot collect debris that is too large or too heavy to be loaded safely into our vehicles.

## **Bulk/Junk**

Republic Services will collect furniture and other large, non-metal household items placed curbside at **no extra charge**, limited to bulk items equivalent to 2 cubic yards or 4'x4'x4'. Bulk pick up is provided and will be placed with trash on second pickup day. **For bulk items weighing more than 75 pounds or longer/ wider than 4 feet** see "Special Pickup Items" section for clarification.

## **Special Pickup Items**

Containers or bundles weighing more than 75 pounds or longer than 4 feet in length, commercial construction trash/ renovation debris will not be collected as household trash. Resident's will be required to call the Customer Service Center to preschedule pickup with additional billing to homeowner.

### **Allowed**

- Furniture (includes mattresses, small/lightweight sofas, chairs, tables, cabinets, etc.)
- Lawn furniture
- Barbecue grills (do not include propane tanks)
- Toys
- Lawnmowers and other power equipment (oil and gas must be drained)
- Carpet & padding (bundled into rolls less than 6' long and 1' in diameter - MAXIMUM of one 11' x 11' room per pickup)
- Lumber and wood trim less than 4 feet in length, nails hammered down or removed - Republic will collect a MAXIMUM of 12-15 pcs per pickup
- Cabinets, vanities, toilets & sinks
- Flat screen TVs 42" and under. Older TVs 32" and under and computers, monitors and other electronics
- Books, clothing, nick-knacks
- Dishes, pots and pans
- Basketball goals (pole must be broken down to 4-5' to fit in collection vehicle)

### **Not Allowed**

- Tree limbs, tree stumps, logs, firewood or yard waste (more information about yard waste collection)
- Refrigerators, freezers, A/C units and other refrigeration equipment that has not had the chemical refrigerant removed by a licensed technician (more information)
- Appliances (more information about items with chemical refrigerants)
- Hazardous household waste (paints, stains, pesticides, etc.)
- Bricks, tiles, concrete products, rocks or stones
- Construction debris, including drywall, cement board, shingles and insulation (more information about disposal of construction debris)
- Tires (on or off rim)
- Automotive parts
- TVs over 42"
- Pianos
- Pool tables
- Floor model copiers and printers
- Riding mowers
- Items too large or heavy to be lifted safely by a two-person crew or too large to fit into the collection vehicle
