Applications must be complete to commence the review process. The Association's Common Interest Community Manager, PMI-Prince William (PMI), will do a preliminary review of the application package to ensure that it contains all needed information and may request additional information before transmitting it to the ACC for review. <u>Incomplete applications will be returned to the applicant with a statement of deficiencies that must be remedied and resubmitted prior to ACC review.</u>

The requirement for ACC approval of outside changes (as set in the HOA's Declaration) is as follows:

No Living Unit or other structure or improvement shall be commenced, erected, placed, moved, altered or maintained, and no exterior addition to or change (including any change in color) or alteration shall be made, until complete plans and specifications therefor, together with such other information as shall be requested by the Architectural Control Committee, shall have been submitted to and approved in writing by the Architectural Control Committee as to harmony of external design, color and location in relation to surrounding structures, natural vegetation and topography.
