REPLACEMENT BULBS AND GLOBES

Homeowners may contact **Patrick McLean** for replacement **60-Watt soft white compact florescent light bulbs (CFLs)** for their lampposts. **All bulbs on the entire street should have the same wattage and color rendition.**

The 12-inch plastic globes (with a 4-inch neck) for the lamppost fixtures may be procured at: www.lamppostglobes.com. Buy the "white" polycarbonate globes.



PETS: PLEASE REMIND YOUR OWNERS

To the pet owners of the neighborhood: Fairfax County Code Title 41 requires pet owners to have their pet on a leash when left outside and to pick up their pet's waste.

If anyone observes a violation, call the Fairfax County Police at the non-emergency number: 703-691-2131.

Lastly, please DO NOT dispose of animal waste into the sewer drains.

NEIGHBORHOOD CRIME REPORT

Please report to the police any suspicious activity on our streets or in the common areas. There is evidence of alcohol drinking and smoking in the common areas on a routine basis. Bottles are often thrown into the street or grass from passing cars. If you see anything suspicious, please contact 911 or the Fairfax County Police Department Non-Emergency Line at 703-691-2131. The best deterrent is a vigilant neighborhood.

SELLING YOUR HOME

When selling your home you (or your Realtor) will need to request an HOA packet from the board. The cost is \$150.00 (check payable to Wooded Glen Section 1 HOA) and once payment is received, the packet will be prepared. The packet will be available for pick-up within 10 days from payment receipt. The HOA packet includes a variety of information for the new homeowners, such as the Association's Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws, budget, notice of current or pending architectural violations, and architectural guidelines.

HOW TO CHANGE THE EXTERIOR OF YOUR HOUSE

Does the color of your house need a change? Do you wish you had a back deck or fence around your yard or do you want to change the one you have? Do you have a tree that needs to be removed? If so, then you have to request approval for an exterior change of your house from the Architectural Control Committee (ACC). The Wooded Glen guidelines state: "Applications shall be submitted to the Committee in an original plus five copies or electronically at acc@woodedglenhoa.org Applications shall contain detailed drawings of changes to be made. Such drawings shall clearly indicate the location of existing structures, and property boundary lines."

The approval process is simple; use the form located on our website or write a letter explaining exactly what you want to do, add a drawing and, if painting is involved, submit a sample of the color(s). Then e-mail the request or deliver the original request and 5 copies to the Chairperson of the ACC, Mr. Walt Zimmers. He will circulate your request to

the other members of the ACC and get back to you shortly. Written approval of changes, additions or improvements to your home is a requirement of our Homeowners' Association. SPRING & SUMMER HOME REMINDERS

A maintenance check carried out in the spring makes for a simpler summer. Here are some friendly reminders:

- Change the batteries in your smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors and replace them if necessary (get one if you don't have one).
- Check and ensure drains in and outside the house are clear of obstructions.
- Vacuum around refrigerators especially behind.
- Check your dryer vents to make sure they are working properly and are cleared of any backup.
- Pressure-wash your house and deck/patio and bring outdoor furniture out of storage.
- Check for and repair cracks in driveway/sidewalk. Spring is the best time to seal cracks in the driveway or any other concrete.
- Replace any burnt out bulbs on the exterior lights.
- Trim tree branches and bushes off windows, siding, and lampposts.
- Trim branches and move border rocks at least 6-inches off sides of sidewalks.
- Inspect and clear rain gutters of leaves.
- Check for any loose or missing roof shingles or siding.
- Check/replace filters for heat pumps and furnaces.
- Check and clean air ducts and registers.
- Have fireplace chimneys inspected and cleaned.

- Check wooden decks/porches for loose nails and rotted wood.
- Help keep sidewalks safe by shoveling snow as soon as feasible.
